

Erhard Junghans: Signs of the times.

Erhard Junghans was born in the Black Forest on 1 January 1823. In 1861, he and his brotherin-law founded the Junghans company in Schramberg, where he would set many things in motion in just nine years until his early death. The visionary Erhard Junghans recognised the signs of the times early on: to compete against cheap imported watches, he introduced new innovative manufacturing processes - and laid the foundation for unparalleled success. In 1903, the company became the world's largest watch manufacturer and the name Junghans was internationally synonymous with precision and reliability. These are values that have shaped the brand's identity to this day. In 2023, on the occasion of the 200th anniversary of his birth, we honour Erhard Junghans with two edition models – signs of the times as unique as their namesake.

Any tribute to Erhard Junghans is, of course, also a tribute to classic watch design. It starts with the historical Junghans lettering and ends with the fine Roman numerals on the dial. Acting like elongated indices, they are subtly coordinated with the geometry of the Meister line. The case back is also inspired by its founder: The domed sapphire crystal bears a signature and the twoarmed oscillating weight has an engraved profile of Erhard Junghans: a beautiful reminder that his spirit still drives the company today.





The value of Erhard Junghans' contribution to watch history is inestimable. These edition models, limited to 200 pieces each, pay tribute to this and bear his image and signature on the back. Be it in yellow or white gold, every glance at the Meister fein Automatic Edition Erhard brings 200 years of watch history to life.

Time in flight: A fascination with aviation.

Aviation has always held a special fascination for Junghans. No wonder since historically the fields of aeronautics and chronometry are closely linked. In the 1930s, Junghans manufactured control panel instruments for aeroplanes and airships to measure flight time. In the 1950s, Junghans devised a now legendary pilot chronograph for the German Bundeswehr. The Meister Pilot, which we expand in 2023 with exciting new models, also belongs to this tradition. The Meister Pilot is a visually nostalgic but nonetheless modern watchpiece. It is equipped with state-of-the-art technology that will captivate retro fans, aviation enthusiasts and design connoisseurs alike.



One look at the Meister Pilot Chronoscope Desert is enough to conjure up images of majestic sand dunes in the mind's eye. Whether you're in the desert or in the city, by day or by night, the distinctive luminescent numerals and hands and the sapphire crystal with anti-reflection coating on both sides ensure optimum readability.

A thrilling journey through time. The Junghans Terrassenbau Museum.

Designed by Stuttgart's industrial architect Philipp Jakob Manz, the Junghans terrace building is one of the most spectacular industrial constructions of the early 20th century – an edifice representative of architectural history and watchmaking tradition like no other. This distinction was honoured in 2018 with the opening of the Junghans Terrassenbau Museum in commemoration of its 100th anniversary. Extensively renovated, the listed building invites you along for a most fascinating journey through time – From the worldrenowned Black Forest clocks and the history of Junghans, up until the days of orchestrions and musical clocks. Meister Terrassenbau: A distinctive building. A distinctive watch.



Incorporating defining design features of this industrial landmark, the momentous architecture is fittingly commemorated in the Meister Terrassenbau models: The meandering design of the dial's minute track pays homage to the wall decorations, and the dark green of the alligator leather strap to the wall tiles in the stairways. The case back allows a view of the movement through a glass window in a depiction of the terrace building. Both models are limited to 1,500 watches worldwide.

The enthusiasm for sports has a long history at Junghans, from hand stopwatches in the 1920s to sports timekeeping where Junghans set new standards in the 1960s and after. in 1972, Junghans launched a sporty line of wristwatches. One of the most distinctive models quickly became a coveted collector's item.





Sports performance for the here and now

The 1972 Competition is inspired by this classic watch: the oval case and the pushers and crown placed at the top, as on a hand-held stopwatch, lend an extraordinary dynamic to the watch. The anthracitecoloured dial is in stark contrast to the orange of the totalisers and tachymeter scale. With its state-of-the-art features – from the durable sapphire crystal and screwed crown to the strap fixed with stainless steel screws – the watch projects the typical attitude towards life in the 1970s into the modern day.





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

FORM A Chronoscope

Architect, painter, sculptor and product designer Max Bill was strongly influenced by the Bauhaus philosophy – stripping back to the bare essentials. He viewed his work as "shaping the environment", which required that the results be well designed and practical for everyday use accordingly. This applied in equal measure whether he was occupied with art or product design. After already writing design history with his kitchen, table and wall clocks, 1961 saw the creation of his legendary Junghans wristwatches. These are viewed as design icons today.



Time for Bauhaus.

The state-run Bauhaus was founded more than 100 years ago, and was to prove a long-standing influence on the fields of architecture, art and design. Junghans retains a very special connection with the minimalistic style of this school of thought through Bauhaus scholar Max Bill. The philosophy of the Bauhaus lives on in our max bill models.

Minimalistic design with red highlights: the red doors of the Bauhaus building are adopted by the two Bauhaus models in the line – this detail would have immediately caught the attention of Max Bill on his very first visit to Dessau. A journey through time



In collaboration with his brother-in-law, Erhard Junghans establishes **"Zeller & Junghans"** as a business producing clock parts. Initially manufacturing components for Black Forest clocks, the first of their own clocks appeared in 1866.





An annual production of three million clocks cements Junghans's position as the **largest clock manufacturer on earth**. In the meantime, with production sites and subsidiaries not only in the Black Forest, but also in other locations including Venice and Paris.

Designed by architect Philipp Jakob Manz, the 9-level **terrace building** was completed after a two year construction period. The first Junghans hand-wound watches were produced here in 1927.





Numerous movements were designed and manufactured here from the 1930s. The premium calibres are the heart of the Meister watches, and go on to augment the collection onwards of 1936.

The company Diehl GmbH assumes a majority share. Junghans becomes the **third largest manufacturer of chronometers worldwide**, and the following year unveils the very first automatic chronometer calibre with the J83. The collaboration with Max Bill begins.



In its **100th anniversary year**, Junghans is exporting watches to 100 different countries, with 20,000 watches and alarm clocks being produced daily. The wristwatches designed by Max Bill are unveiled.

Junghans is acquired by the luxury goods group **EGANAGoldpfeil.**



With the **patented multi-frequency radio-controlled movement**, Junghans watches are now able to receive time signals in different countries.





Junghans proves their mechanical competence with the intricate J325 hand-winding movement. A multitude of components for the Erhard Junghans 1 model, an homage to the company's founder, are designed and produced in Schramberg.



Outstanding **prospects for the Junghans brand** and the Schramberg site: With the new owners, Dr. Hans-Jochem and Hannes Steim, the company regains its independence.



Junghans celebrates its 150th anniversary – with an official ceremony on its jubilee day and opening of the new company museum a day later. New life is breathed into the Meister range.



A cultural heritage worth protecting: The Steim family purchases buildings of significance on the plot in the Geisshalde, not least the **now listed terrace building.** At the same time, investments are made in new assembly lines and the development of new generations of movements.

The **new FORM line** stands for a clear design language in the tradition of the globally-renowned German industrial design.

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
